Feb, 1998~Sept, 1999

Participated in two training deployments aboard the Coast Guard's three-masted, square-rigged sail training vessel *Eagle* totaling ten weeks in 1998 and 1999. Accompanied a research vessel whose mission was to deploy three research buoys in the mid-Pacific Ocean on either side of the Equator. Photographs I took of the initial buoy deployment were transmitted via satellite back to Woods Hole where they became among the first pictures ever put on display (and circulated via the institution's web site) of an ongoing WHOI expedition while still at sea.
